



COMMUNICATIONS UPDATE

Level 1 Measures State-wide will be introduced from 12:01am Thursday, 31 March 2022.

The Western Australian Government has announced that from **12:01am, Thursday, 31 March 2022**, public health and social measures will ease across WA to modified Level 1 measures.

The new **Level 1** measures consist of the following:

Mask Wearing

- Mask wearing will continue to be required for people aged 8 years and above (and Year 3 and over in school), other than in the home (usual exemptions from mask requirements apply).

Density and Capacity Limits

The **2 square metre (2sqm)** rule applies to Places of Worship from **12:01am, Thursday, 31 March 2022**. Contact registration is not required at Places of Worship.

Hospitals, Aged and Disability Care Facilities

- The limit of **2 visitors** will remain per resident/per day to residential aged and disability care facilities. **Proof of vaccination** applies for visitors.
- There will also be no change concerning essential visitors allowed to hospitals, for:
 - compassionate reasons such as end of life
 - accompanying a child or patient with complex needs
 - birthing partner
 - carer of a person with a disability, chronic illness and frailty.
